On Monday, June 13, 2022, at 6:00 pm, there will be a Called Session of the Charge Conference of The First United Methodist Church of Beaumont, Texas, for the singular purpose of considering the sale of the Brentwood Parsonage at the recommendation of The Board of Trustees of First United Methodist Church of Beaumont, Texas. The reasoning behind the Trustees recommendation include the following: the financial issues of tenancy and taxes for a 501c3 non-profit religious organization, the present vacancy of the parsonage, and the age and current need of updating of the parsonage. You may remember that our Discipleship Pastor Julius Wardley and our District Superintendent Romonica Malone-Wardley have the District Parsonage as their residence. The listing price will be \$289,000.00.




EIGHT YEARS OF SERVING CP
